Shown in front of the Pullen & Geissler Store is a 1906 Cadillac, with a flare-fendered Oldsmobile parked in front of Dodge's Clothing. These sat on the east side of S. Granite Ave., where Windermere Realty and the Liquor Store are located today

C.R. Bockmier was driving the stage from Hartford to Granite Falls when he parked in front of the Lochsloy Post Office (now part of the big store/gas complex on SR 92), with passengers inside and mail bags on the hood of the 1912 Cadillac.

But the guys really enjoying their vehicle are the two young boys with ice cream, sitting on the front of the stage in 1917, parked in front of the Post Office (bank building in the background).
